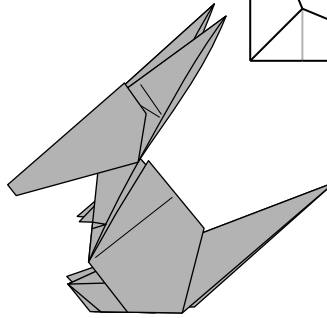
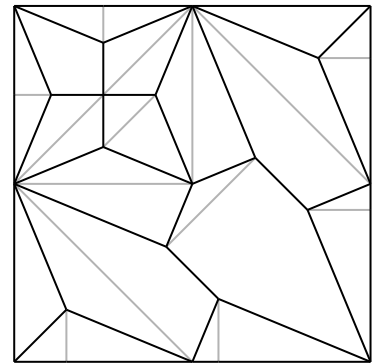


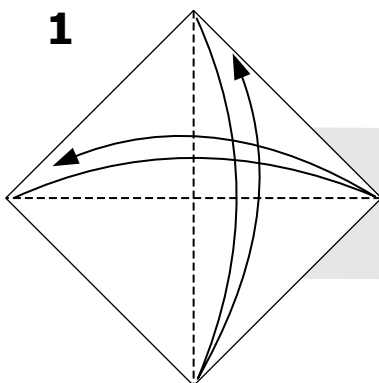
# Little Aardvark

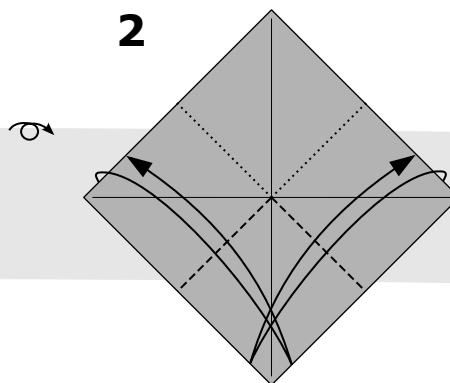

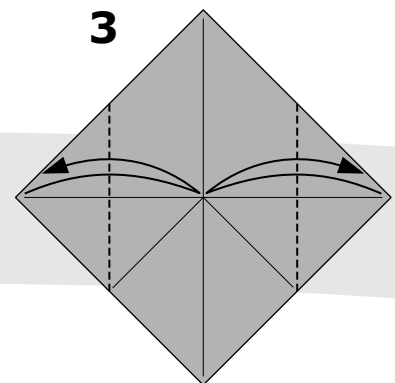

 Start with the colored face facing down. Fold and unfold.

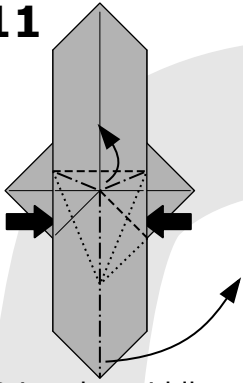

 Turn over, fold and unfold. Crease only on the dashed region. Leave the dotted lines uncreased.



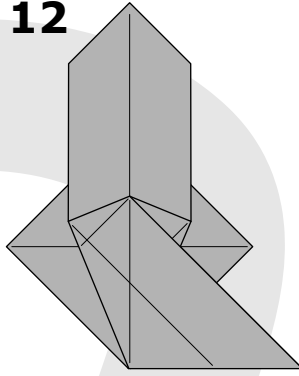
